

Separating Your Debris

Debris should be placed curbside, without blocking the roadway or storm drains.

MAKE 3 SEPARATE PILES;
DO NOT MIX



VEGETATIVE DEBRIS

At the curb:

- Logs
- Plants
- Larger tree branches

Containerize:

- Leaves
- Small branches and twigs
- Pine straw
- Pine cones



APPLIANCES & WHITE GOODS

- Air conditioners
- Dishwashers
- Freezers
- Refrigerators
- Stoves
- Washers, dryers
- Water heaters



CONSTRUCTION & DEMOLITION DEBRIS

- Building materials
- Carpet
- Drywall
- Furniture
- Lumber
- Mattresses
- Plumbing



Debris should **NOT** be in the road, under a tree, next to a pole, under power lines, or otherwise obstructed.

PLACE WITHIN 7 FEET OF THE CURB

OTHER ITEMS

Normal Household Trash & Recycling

Normal household trash, recycling and bagged debris of any kind will not be picked up with storm debris. You should continue to follow your normal garbage and recycling removal schedule.



ELECTRONICS

- Computers
- Radios
- Stereos
- Televisions
- Other corded devices

Electronics should be taken to the Ann Street Landfill or other County landfills/container sites that take them. To see which container sites take these items, log onto <https://tinyurl.com/yayjerkg>



HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE

- Cleaning supplies
- Batteries
- Lawn chemicals
- Oils
- Oil-based paints and stains
- Pesticides
