

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE AMENDING ARTICLE 30-5, DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS, OF CHAPTER 30, THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, that:

Section 1. Section 30-5.B.5, Public Tree Protection Standards, is amended by deleting Section n, Privilege License and Insurance, in its entirety and substituting the following:

n. Permission and Insurance Required

It shall be unlawful for any person or firm to engage in the business or occupation of pruning, treating, or removing any publicly-owned tree without first obtaining permission from the City. Permission shall not be required for any PWC, public service, or City employee. The person or firm shall first file evidence of possession of liability insurance in the minimum amounts of \$1,000,000.00 for bodily injury or death, and \$100,000.00 property damage indemnifying the City or any person injured or damaged resulting from the pursuit of such endeavors as described in this article.

Section 2. It is the intention of the City Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code or Ordinances, City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, and the section of this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.
