

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE AMENDING ARTICLE 30-5, DEVELOPMENT STANDARDS, OF CHAPTER 30, THE UNIFIED DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE, OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA

BE IT ORDAINED, by the City Council of the City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, that:

Section 1. Section 30-5.A.11., Off-Street Circulation, is amended by deleting the paragraph in Section c, Stacking Lanes for Parking Lot Entrances, in its entirety and substituting the following:

Nonresidential uses shall provide stacking lanes between the edge of the street right-of-way and entrances into off-street parking areas in accordance with the minimum stacking lane distance established in Table 30-5.A.11.C, Stacking Lanes for Parking Lots, and Figure 30-5.A.11.c. **Except in the Downtown (DT) district or if the site has two or more driveways.**

Section 2. It is the intention of the City Council, and it is hereby ordained that the provisions of this ordinance shall become and be made part of the Code or Ordinances, City of Fayetteville, North Carolina, and the section of this ordinance may be renumbered to accomplish such intention.
