

**AMENDMENT TO
CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION**

AN AMENDMENT TO THE DECLARATION ISSUING A STATE OF EMERGENCY WITHIN THE CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE, NORTH CAROLINA, PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 1A, CHAPTER 166A, N.C.G.S.; N.C.G.S. § 166A-19.22; AND CHAPTER 9 OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, CITY OF FAYETTEVILLE

THAT WHEREAS, on a State of Emergency Declaration for the City Limits of the City of Fayetteville was executed and imposed on the 17th day of March, 2020, in response to the pandemic of the novel coronavirus known as COVID-19; and

WHEREAS, the current conditions as a result of the pandemic of COVID-19 warrant that the City of Fayetteville amend the State of Emergency Declaration executed and imposed on March 17, 2020; and

WHEREAS, on March 23, 2020, North Carolina Governor Roy Cooper that under an executive order schools will remain closed through May 15, 2020; several businesses will be required to close; and the limit for gatherings will be lowered to 50.

NOW, THEREFORE, the State of Emergency Declaration is amended as follows:

1. **Section 2. Limitations on Organized Assemblages on City-Owned Property**, is Amended in its entirety to incorporate Governor Roy Cooper's Executive Order issued on March 23, 2020.
2. **Section 4. Other actions necessary to maintain order and protect lives and property**, is Amended to incorporate and include the provisions of Governor Roy Cooper's Executive Order issued on March 23, 2020 regarding the closing of gyms, movie theaters, sweepstakes parlors, health clubs and similar facilities as well as other businesses that by the nature of their business are unable to conduct social distancing including but not limited to hair and nail salons, barbershops and massage therapists no later than 5:00 pm on Wednesday, March 25, 2020.

THEREFORE, I, MAYOR, DO HEREBY DECLARE AN AMENDMENT TO THE STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION.

AND THAT FURTHER, THE PROVISIONS OF THE STATE OF EMERGENCY DECLARATION SHALL BE INCORPORATED HEREIN IN FULL FORCE AND EFFECT.
